

This year, the event is divided into 4 Divisions– Amateur Division I (Pee Wee through Junior), Amateur Division II (Senior through Adult), and repeated age divisions for Master Level Teams. Teams who that attend NCHC sanctioned competitions and place 1st, 2nd or 3rd receive an invitation to dance at the event. Each team who places 1st, 2nd or 3rd at this years event is extended an invitation to return next year to the USA National Championships to defend their titles next year held Labor Day weekend 2019 at the Gaylord Opryland Hotel as well.

This two day, two stage event comprised over 300 team dances, 50 duos/ duets, 225 solos, 35 choreographed solos, comprising over 700 competition dancers from GA, CO, IN, SC, TN, FL, NC, MS, MO, KY, and MT

This year we added a special award to honor Bill Nichols "the Grandfather of Clogging" who recently passed. The Bill Nichols Traditional Team Award symbolizes the best of the Traditional Couple routines danced for the day.
