While the required courses can be completed online at self-pace within two weeks and face-to-face at the national clogging convention, the accumulation of mandatory and elective points often takes a year or more. The CCI leadership, which is in charge of all matters related to the program, realizes that some clogging instructors who want to participate in the program and receive the Certified Clogging Instructor designation, may have been teaching for many years, and may have gained a great amount of experience and knowledge on their own. The "CCI Fast Track" has been established to allow these individuals flexibility in dealing with the "Points Log" by considering their personal experiences. FIVE YEARS of teaching <u>CLOGGING</u>, has been established as the minimum requirement in applying for this option.

The Certified Clogging Instructor Steering Committee, which is in charge of all matters related to the program, realizes that some clogging instructors who wish to receive the CCI designation have many years of teaching experience and have gained a great amount of knowledge on their own. The CCI Fast Track was established just for you. This Fast Track program allow these individuals a flexibility in dealing with the "Points Log" by considering personal experiences.

While some of our committee may be familiar with you, your background, teaching ability, and prior work, others may not know you at all. Therefore, in completing this application, please be thorough and specific in all your answers, giving dates, times, names, and locations in the personal clogging history and teaching sections. Please provide copies as requested, and realize that more is better. Also, feel free to attach a resume or personal biography that you may have prepared, other materials documenting your clogging career, and please use additional paper if there is not enough space provided on the form.

You may apply for "CCI Fast Track" as soon as you have completed your face-to-face CCI classroom session. Please notify your CCI mentor of your intent to apply for Fast Track. You will be required to complete all mandatory points plus five additional cue sheets and videos. Once you have completed this application, please send it along with the requested material to:
